DIY Adhesive Artistamp Celebrate National Sticker Day by creating your own adhesive art!

Collect

- · 4 packets of unflavored gelatin
- White vinegar
- Paint brush
- Paper
- Decorating materials
- Saucepan
- Stovetop
- Adult safety partner

Create the adhesive

- 1. Pour six tablespoons of white vinegar into a saucepan.
- 2. With an adult's help, heat the vinegar over the stove until it is almost boiling.
- 3. Remove the saucepan from the heat and pour in the four packets of gelatin.
- 4. Carefully stir the ingredients together.

Make it sticky

- 5. While the mixture is still warm, use a paintbrush to coat one side of a few sheets of paper.
- 6. Set each piece of paper aside to dry.

Decorate your stamps

- 7. Once the papers have dried, cut them into smaller stamp sized pieces.
- 8. Decorate the non-coated side however you like. Consider making a stamp to honor a family member, your favorite pet, favorite place, or a cartoon character.

Stick it!

9. When you are ready to stick your stamp to something, simply moisten the back with a damp sponge or lick it!

What are artistamps?

Artistamps, or artist stamps, are non-governmental issued stamps that depict anything that the creator chooses to commemorate and are used as envelope decoration. What will you decorate with the artistamp that you create?
